The Director of Children's Formation is a key member of the church staff and will work collaboratively with the rector, curate, Director of Music and volunteers to help create and foster an environment where children may fall in love with God.

Responsibilities:

-  Seek to establish both depth and breadth of relationships within parish with special emphasis given to families.
-  Recruit and Equip volunteers for Sunday School, Vacation Bible School and other programs as needed.
-  Direct the Sunday School programs for nursery through 6th grade.
-  Recruit for and implement Vacation Bible School for one week each summer.
-  Oversee and implement children's chapel with direction and support from clergy.
-  Perform all other duties as assigned by the Rector.

St. John's is a thriving parish with an average Sunday attendance of 360 members. Our children's formation has over 100 children attending and over 60 adults regularly attend our Adult Forum. We are growing and are looking for a Director of Formation to aid in that growth.
