Treasurer's Report - Kelly

- Executive Summary:
 - Continued strong financial health from a YTD view. Current pledges vs. plate offerings breakout was not clear in the first half of the year but overall aligned within \$15K. Metered parking had strong summer months (May Aug) vs conservative budget.
 - Our budget assumes \$540K in pledges, current commitment is less than that but strong parking revenue offsets.
 - Expenses essentially within budgeted expectations with a few exceptions due to timing plus the continued higher maintenance costs this year associated with the boiler repairs and higher than budgeted gas expenses.
- No Endowment draw because of parking income
- Draft of budget for 2020 will be brought forward at the January meeting so that we can present it at the annual mtg
