Treasurer's Report - Kelly

Executive Summary: Financial YTD review includes May, June & July (last detailed report was in April). A review was underway to understand the current pledges vs. plate offerings, not much changed. Metered parking had strong summer months (May, Jun & Jul) vs conservative budget. Our budget assumes \$540K in pledges, current commitment is approximately \$___K. Expenses essentially within budgeted expectations with a few exceptions due to timing plus the continued higher maintenance costs this year associated with the boiler repairs and higher than budgeted gas expenses.

Audit Update: 2018 we will have a review audit (similar to 2016). Potential to amend 2016 return.

Outlook: Will complete an outlook for October's meeting to gauge where we will end the year

July financials (May, June, July in YTD)

- Revenue:
 - o Michelle reviewing names to see who has given in the past
 - As of July 1 total income from Optima lot now comes to us \$6,000 more coming for July
 - New lease terms will bring in an extra (approx.)\$20,000 (unbudgeted)
- Expense:
 - Overhaul of boiler to prepare for winter; upgrade for efficiency and optimal operation for the coming winter
- Made it through the summer without tapping endowment (parking, negotiating with Cambridge)
